History of Second Baptist Church of Homestead, PA

The church is more than a religious organization; it is an organism with Christ as the living head. The members differ from each other, yet they function as one in the will of God. If one member suffers, the whole body suffers; if one is honored, all are honored; and the members should use their spiritual gifts to minister to all in love. (1 Corinthians 12:12-27). To be a part of this church, you must be spiritually born into it. Jesus Christ has made a way for all; He said, whosoever will, let him come.

Our church, Second Baptist Church of Homestead, began with the thought that the lower part of Homestead needed a black church. God touched a local preacher, brother Prince Cunningham in a vision in 1905, and a church in the lower section of town was started. This missionary church began with a few people and was located at 226 Sixth Avenue in 1905.

In 1908, Reverend N. S. Lane successfully petitioned the council to recognize Second Baptist Church as a power for God and as a part of the Baptist denomination in Homestead. Reverend Lane soon left and Reverend Z. A. Jones became the next pastor. Following his resignation, both Reverend N.T. Love and Reverend Bundy pastored for a short period of time.

In November 1914, Reverend James Douglas Morton became the pastor of Second Baptist Church. During his tenure, the Sunday School, BYPU, the choir, and the Pastors Aid were organized. In addition, the first property 222 Sixth Avenue was purchased for \$6,500 in June 1915. In 1924 the church purchased property at Fourth Avenue and Amity Street for \$15,000.

From 1924 until 1940, the church grew under the leadership of Reverend James Morton. During that period, the following ministries were established: the Missionary Circle, Sunday School, Young Women's and Junior Missionary Circles, the Pulpit Aide Society, and the Cross Bearers Chorus. Additionally, the Willing Workers, the Usher Board, the Young People's Group, the Nurses Court, and both a Senior and Junior Choir were initiated. We became a member of the Allegheny Baptist General Association, now known as the AUBA. Some of the leaders heading these groups include Brother Edward Coles, Sister Sadie Morton, Sister Indiana James, Sister Lillie Mae Green, Sister Kalup Bell, Brother Luther Walker, Sister Henrietta Mathis, and Brother Russell Jefferson.

Due to the attack on Pearl Harbor in December 1941 and the commencement of World War II, all homes and buildings in lower Homestead were raised for Carnegie Illinois Steel Corporation. The federal government purchased the church for \$35,000, causing us to move to the fourth ward school on Ninth Avenue. During the next few years, the church moved to the Newman's funeral chapel, shared a location with Clark Memorial Baptist Church under Reverend Edgar P. Tunie, and then moved to our permanent location here on West Street and 12th Avenue on March 4, 1945.

Reverend Morton passed in August 1951, resulting in the name of Senior Missionary Circle being changed to the J.D. Morton Missionary. Reverend O.C. Perkins was installed as pastor on January 5, 1953, and served until his resignation in 1964. Under his leadership, the main

auditorium was erected the Cross Bearers chorus and the J.D. Morton Missionary donated the stained glass windows, one located in the front and the other in back of the sanctuary.

From 1966 until 1970 Reverend Booker T. Crosby became pastor at Second Baptist Church. Under his leadership, the Layman's League and the Young People's Choir were organized.

Second Baptist Church began a new era with the installation of Reverend Donald P. Turner in March 1971. During his tenure, the following organizations commenced: Teens for Christ, Wednesday Night Bible Study, Senior Birthday Program, Benevolent Fund, Friday Night Bible Study for Men, Buddy Fellowship, Singles Ministry, Weed and Seed program, established computer classes, Scholarship Committee, the Economic Education Committee, the Mass Choir, the Hallelujah Gospel Chorus and changed the Young People's Choir to the Gospelites. Further, he encouraged Second Baptist contributions to the following organizations: Lott Carey Foreign Mission, Greater Pittsburgh Food Bank, Sickle Cell Anemia Foundation, MUSA, and the Salvation Army.

Church expansion and renovations took place in 1978. An educational section, pastor study, restrooms, a new front on the church, new baptismal pool, new windows, chandeliers, carpeting, pews, air conditioning, and the kitchen was remodeled by 1979. The year 1984 highlights a visit from Reverend Jesse Jackson during his presidential campaign which was followed by a prayer breakfast and political rally.

In the 80's, Second Baptist Church commissioned Dr. Sheila Renae Daniel to open the Eloise and Edith Christian Day School. Sister Edith Dickerson started the A Prayer and A Donut Ministry. Lastly, Sister Barbara Moore coordinated Vacation Bible School for children ages 4-16.

In 2002, we were able to purchase property once owned by Grace Christian Ministries of Munhall. In April 2003, we dedicated the Second Baptist Ministry Hall with an afternoon service, led by Reverend William C. Callaway. In 2005, Youth Church was created for ages 5-17 under the leadership of Minister Charles Hill Sr. Pastor Turner served as pastor until his retirement in May 2019, which concluded his 48 year tenure as the longest serving pastor.

Praise God for a new era under the leadership of Reverend Laphon Flood-Francis, who was installed as our youngest pastor in our church's history in November 2024. We strongly believe God has anointed him to be the guardian of our church, leading us into the future with guidance from God Almighty. Since his tenure, our congregation has shifted, increased, and is under renovation both in spirit and the physical building. Pastor Flood-Francis has expanded our reach by orchestrating digital evangelism; resulting in online giving increases, the creation of Second Baptist Church's YouTube and Instagram, updating Facebook, and developing the church website. Under his leadership, we have begun new outreach initiatives and services; such as Wrapped in Grace Outreach, New Membership Classes redeveloped as New Discipleship Classes, offers a more comprehensive curriculum for Wednesday Bible Study, Beyond the Grave Service, expanded our Holy Week Service, and establishment of the Reverend Donald P. Turner

and First Lady Norma Jean Turner Scholarships for youth. Although it has only been a short period of time, we have seen church growth spiritually through baptisms, discipleship and church membership, while also growing physically with renovations to the church dining hall, pastor's office, conference room, and parking lot. This is only the beginning of a new generation of believers at our church. Second Baptist is on fire for Jesus, ready to preach, teach, and uphold the standards of God's commandments. We look forward to serving and the preparation of purpose the Lord has designed for what we call, the best church on this side of heaven.

Pastor Courtney D. Meadows is a seasoned pastor, prolific preacher, and community advocate with over a decade of transformational leadership in ministry, nonprofit sectors, and civic engagement. Renowned for his dynamic preaching style and innovative approach, Pastor Meadows has inspired audiences and communities across the globe.

Pastor Meadows' ministry journey began at the age of six when he delivered his first sermon at Peoples Missionary Baptist Church in Montgomery, Alabama. In 2012, he was licensed and ordained at Maggie Street Baptist Church under the leadership of

Pastor Ezekiel Pettway, marking the start of a lifelong commitment to preaching the gospel. His evangelistic ministry has since taken him across the United States and Africa, where his powerful messages of hope, resilience, and purpose have touched countless lives.

Currently, Pastor Meadows serves as the Senior Pastor of Central Baptist Church in Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania's Historic Hill District. With a passion for visionary leadership, he is guiding the church into a season of spiritual renewal, strategic ministry growth, and community engagement. Alongside his pastoral leadership, he serves as the President and CEO of Central New Development Corporation, an initiative dedicated to fostering economic empowerment, social justice, and revitalization efforts within the Hill District and greater Pittsburgh community.

Pastor Meadows began his pastoral journey as the senior pastor of First Missionary Baptist Church of Whitehall, Alabama, where he served from 2012 to 2020. From 2020 to 2022, Pastor Meadows served as Senior Pastor of Hutchinson Missionary Baptist Church. In 2022, Pastor Meadows joined the staff of Grace Baptist Church in Stockbridge, Georgia, as generational pastor.

Pastor Meadows is a proud graduate of Talladega College, where he earned a Bachelor of Business Administration, equipping him with strategic and organizational leadership skills. He is currently pursuing a Master of Divinity at Emory University's Candler School of Theology, further enhancing his theological training and leadership capabilities. A proud member of Alpha Phi Alpha Fraternity, Incorporated, Pastor Meadows upholds the values of scholarship, service, and the uplifting of communities.

Pastor Meadows finds joy and purpose alongside his wife, Roneshia, and their daughter, Rayne. Together, they exemplify a life devoted to love, service, and legacy-building.

Pastor Courtney D. Meadows continues to lead with integrity, inspire with conviction, and serve with compassion. His journey is a testament to the transformative power of faith and the limitless possibilities of a life dedicated to purpose.

In December 2024, Pastor Meadows was honored with an Honorary Doctorate in Humanitarianism from the Board of International Association Volunteers of Community Service and Global International Alliance. Reverend Dr. William H. Curtis

A native of Baltimore, Maryland, Dr. William H. Curtis accepted the call to ministry at the age of 17. For seven years, he served as the Senior Pastor at Shiloh Baptist Church in York, PA; and since 1997, he has served as the Senior Pastor at Mount Ararat Baptist Church in Pittsburgh, PA.

Mount Ararat Baptist Church is a large urban ministry and ministers to more than 10,000 members in the community, providing four well-attended weekend services. Mount Ararat believes in ministry to the whole community, and under the leadership of Dr. Curtis, the church implemented a Community Tithe Program, which returns over ten percent of the congregation's weekly offerings to small churches, parachurch ministries and non-profit organizations.

Dr. Curtis continues an instructor at the United Theological Seminary and has graduated several groups of doctoral students at the institution. Aside from pastoral instruction, he is Co-Owner of The Church Online, a successful technology and full-service marketing firm that provides top of the line services to ministries all over the world.

His Board relationships include: Amachi Pittsburgh, the Pittsburgh Sports and Exhibition Authority, the Pittsburgh Theological Seminary, The Ellis School, the Interdenominational Theological Center, and the Baptist School of Theology. In addition, he served as President the Hampton University Minister's Conference from 2007 – 2011; and in 2024, he was invited to serve on the Inaugural Board of Advisors for the Hampton University School of Religion. In February 2016, Pennsylvania Governor Tom Wolf assigned him to the Governor's Advisory Commission on African American Affairs. In January 2018, he was elected to serve on the Allegheny County Airport Authority Board. In July 2020, the Allegheny Health Network elected him to serve on their Cancer Institute Advisory Board. In February 2021, he was elected to the Faithlife Corporation Board. In August 2022, the United Theological Seminary elected him to serve on the President's Advisory Council and in 2023, he was elected to the United's Trustee Board where he served until 2025. In late 2022, he was elected to the Board of Diamond Run Golf Club. His fraternity memberships include: Omega Psi Phi Fraternity, Sigma Pi Phi, and Jericho lodge #20.

Dr. Curtis has been the recipient of numerous honors and awards. In 2009, he was inducted into the Martin Luther King Jr. Board of Preachers of Morehouse College. In the spring of 2010, Dr. Curtis moved from the speaking arena into the publishing arena with his first book, "FAITH -- Learning to Live Without Fear," which is currently in its fourth printing. His second book, "Dressed for Victory: Putting on the Full Armor of God" was released in April 2015. And, his third book "Mentor Shift" was published in May 2019. "One Day Closer" a compilation of his mediations during the Pandemic shut-in from March 2020 thru May 2021 was published in June 2021; and it was followed by "One Day Closer" – Volume 2 which was published in June 2022.

Dr. Curtis holds a Bachelor of Arts Degree in Religious Studies and Philosophy from Morgan State University, a Master of Divinity Degree from Howard University School of Divinity, and a Doctor of Ministry Degree from United Theological Seminary in Dayton, Ohio.

Dr. Curtis is married to the former Christine Y. Richardson, and they are the proud parents of one lovely daughter, Dr. Houston M. Curtis.



Rev. Jennifer L. Carner, Ph.D.

The Rev. Dr. Jennifer L. Carner is the daughter of Pastor J.W. Carner and Brenda Carner. She served in ministry with her father for several years. Under his leadership, she was licensed to preach and bring authentic transformation to the Kingdom and the world in August of 2000. She was later ordained at Greater Travelers Rest Baptist Church, in 2008. Jennifer has served as the first female Executive/Lead Pastor of The Greater Travelers Rest Baptist Church in Decatur, GA,

where Dr. E. Dewey Smith, Jr. is the Senior Pastor. She currently provides preaching and teaching support to the Senior Pastor.

Jennifer has a passion for Homiletics, Communications Theory, and higher learning and has earned a Ph.D. in African American Preaching and Sacred Rhetoric from Christian Theological Seminary in Indianapolis, IN. Dr. Jen's dissertation centered on the history of African American preaching.

Dr. Jen has recently accepted a position as the Director the Preaching in a Post-Christian Age Initiative and Assistant Professor of Homiletics, at Pittsburgh Theological Seminary in Pittsburgh, PA. This initiative aims to resource pastors, new faith community leaders, and preachers to address the challenges of presenting the gospel in our nation's current cultural, social, and political contexts.

Jennifer has also published her first book entitled, 31 Days of Winning, a Devotional Journal. She describes her first published work in this way. "Preachers, influencers, and creatives are human. Faith and spirituality do not exempt us from heartbreak. 31 Days of Winning is a compilation of the words that helped me find the will to show up in my own life. It is my prayer that these words will help others the way that they helped me."

Dr. Jen has been inducted into the esteemed Morehouse Board of Ministers and Laity for her commitment to preaching, teaching, and ministry through a Christocentric and liberationist lens. She seeks to encourage everyone around her. She continues to live out the words of the first song she learned to sing, "I'm just a nobody trying to tell everybody about somebody who can save anybody."
